3. CIFM&MDS will play at the Midwest Mandolin Festival on June 6, from 8-8:30 pm.
4. We'll play for the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in August; specific dates will be announced later.

Eagle Creek Folk Festival Update:

1. Our headline will be Phil and Ann Case. They will play twice and hold two workshops.
2. The CIFM&MDS Big Band will open and close the festival.
3. Dmitri Alano from Hog Eye Navy will be conducting pennywhistle workshops; pennywhistles from Arthur's Music Store will be available for purchase.
4. We'll have an Irish tent at the festival this year. Musicians who frequently play at Brockway Public House will hold sessions and possibly teach workshops. It will be a good chance for them to post flyers promoting Brockway's Monday Night Sessions.  
Jeff Davis of Bluestone Folk School, a ukulele builder and music teacher, will be holding a ukulele workshop. He will possibly perform a short set in the festival.
5. The Eagle Creek Committee will meet again on May 18<sup>th</sup>.
6. The schedule will be set by May 22.
7. The committee reported that we've had opportunities this year to make new friends and connections with other local music groups. We hope to enjoy mutual friendship and promotion in the future.
